A highlight of our meeting was the visit to the **Jelling Monuments**, a UNESCO World Heritage site. The Jelling stones, often called "Denmark's birth certificate," are an important part of Viking history and gave us a unique cultural perspective. This visit provided an opportunity to connect **history, nature, and sustainability**—elements that align perfectly with the goals of our project.
